# I knew you'd come

I came across a story about a young soldier who lay dying, stranded in no man's land. A fierce battle raged around him. Suddenly he opened his eyes, and saw, leaning over him, the face of his best mate. His friend had risked everything to be by his side in his final moments. They grasped one another's hands, and the dying soldier murmured "I knew you'd come". He quietly slipped away, consoled by the presence of his faithful friend. We all face at times the awful fear that we are alone. But today's gospel should put that fear to rest. Jesus tells us that our God's deep and loving presence is always with us. God's home is in our hearts, in the very core of our being.

The saints understood this very well. Our own Mary Mackillop wrote that "if we have love in our hearts. we will have God with us". She also spoke about her very real sense of "God's watchful presence" within her as she went about her life. God's closeness was, for her, the amazing reality behind the ordinary events of each day. She felt a sense of lasting companionship.

It's so easy to be swept up in our busy, hectic schedules. We can forget that God is with us, in all the crossing places of our lives. When we are mindful of the Sacred Presence within, we experience a peace which, Jesus says, the world cannot give us. The late Cardinal Basil Hume told how, when he was young, he thought of the God within as a stern, rule-enforcing figure. His God was One who would punish him if he took some cookies from the cookie jar. Only as an adult, as he came to know God better, did he understand how wrong his childish perception had been. He realized that, had he taken a biscuit, God would probably have encouraged him to have another one.

It is a gentle, faithful God who is at home with us, and whispers softly in our hearts "Do not be afraid, I am with you". Jesus must return to the Father, but with the Trinity making a home within us, we can open ourselves to meeting God's healing love in our everyday experiences. We don't have to spend our lives seeking God elsewhere. Perhaps we need to ask – how much at home am I. in my ordinariness and frailty, with my God? I'm being invited to a relationship I can hardly begin to imagine - one of deep intimacy, in which I can be myself, with my deepest thoughts and feelings. Do I ever take time to ponder this? The God who inhabits our hearts is one who loves our human condition in all its messiness, and wants to be part of it. Our God is totally accessible. Like the friend who plunged into the heat of the battle to be with his mate, God is up close and personal with each of us. When life pushes us to our limits, can we look within and whisper "I knew you'd come"?
