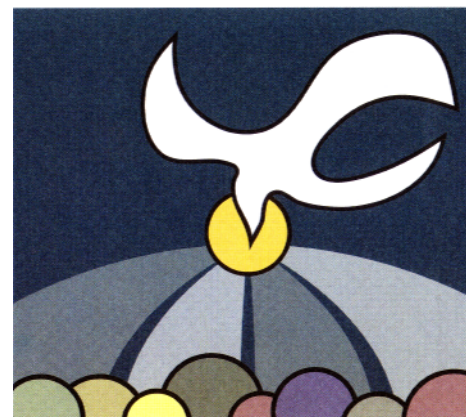

Lord and giver of Life



In today's readings the disciples were "filled with the Holy Spirit," and began to speak in various languages. Inspired, emboldened, and impassioned by the Holy Spirit, they preached the good news of Jesus, crucified and now risen

The crowds were so shocked that Peter felt compelled to assure them that "these men are not drunk." Rather, their courage was fueled by the Holy Spirit, just as God had promised through the prophet Joel: "I (God) will pour out my Spirit...and your young men shall see visions, and your old men shall dream dreams."

This text, along with other stories from the Book of Acts, and the letters of Paul, attest to the very tangible sense that the early Christians had of the

presence of the Spirit, present in them, poured into their hearts (Rom 5:5). They were also very aware of the gifts of the Holy Spirit, gifts given to each and everyone in a particular way that was unique to each person, for the building up of the community.

Today is truly one of the great feasts in the Church's calendar. Today we celebrate the hope that is ours. It is based on the sure knowledge that the Holy Spirit is given to us. We are not alone. The Holy Spirit is with us, guiding us, inspiring us with dreams and visions of a better world, endowing us with gifts in abundance to build that renewed world, and moving us to give ourselves to whatever it is that God calls us to be and do.

How blessed are we, people of the Trinity. Father, Son and Holy Spirit, threefold God of life and love. Glory be to the Father and to the Son and to the Holy Spirit.
