Awakening

A teenager came home from school very upset. He ran into his bedroom and slammed the door. Concerned, the teen's mum went to his room and found him sitting on the side of his bed. She asked him what had happened. He told her that he wasn't selected for the school basketball squad because he was too small. It felt like the end of the world to the lad.

There was no second or third division; no place on the reserve list. There simply wasn't a place for him because of his size. The mother felt her son's pain and disappointment. She reached out and embraced him. She wished she could take away the hurt he felt and make him feel better. Her son needed her now, but what could she do? What could she say? After a while she looked into her son's eyes and said, "Son, you can never be too small. It's not the size of the person in the game that matters, but the size of the game in the person." Next day, this young fellow's mother heard his alarm go off very early. He went out into the backyard and started practicing his basketball. From that day, he practiced every day, morning and evening. He kept repeating to himself those wise words of his mum: It's not the size of the person in the game, but the size of the game in the person." When the next round of school basketball trials arrived, he played with such tremendous skill and precision that he made the team. He made the team each year until he finished school. In fact, he went on to become one of the game's greats – Michael Jordan. Michael's mother saw her son as someone with potential and possibility. She yearned for him to see himself in the same way. She challenged him to look beyond his physical size and to discover the deeper truth and strength longing to be awakened. A similar kind of awakening happens today for Simon Peter, James and John. Jesus sees in these unlikely characters something that he can work with. As often happens in the gospel stories, Jesus takes people where they are, and then calls them to something more through his sharing of the Good News. They are called beyond where they are. They awaken to something far more... Jesus tells the fishermen to disregard their experience up to that point. He tells them to go out and try for a catch, even though they failed to catch anything at all overnight. What the fishermen see in Jesus we do not know. But instead of dismissing him as an interfering know-all they follow his instructions and bring in an enormous catch. But there is a "catch"! From now on, these fishermen will be "catching people." Jesus has awakened in them the call to be disciples, something they would never have thought possible. Like Simon Peter, James and John, Jesus sees potential in all of us to share in his mission as disciples. May Jesus' words, "Put out into deep water...Do not be afraid", awaken these new possibilities in all of us.

As we come and worship, we remember the Wurundjeri People, the original custodians of this land.
